Prepare for Interviews

Bring Your Resume

Bring multiple copies of your resume, printed off; bring at least 2 for each company that you're interested in.

Network with People

Career fairs provide an invaluable opportunity to connect with employers and fellow job-seekers.

Wear Appropriate Attire

You don't need to wear a suit, but know what the appropriate attire is for your profession, & wear that.

Follow Up with Recruiters

Take the time to follow-up with agencies that you spoke with. Writing a "thank you" email to an employer can go a long way.
