## Example Questions to Ask

When thinking of questions, keep them open-ended and focus on three main areas: the role, the company culture, and future opportunities. Here are some examples to get you started:

### About the Role:

- What are the main responsibilities and priorities for this position?
- What does a typical day or week look like in this role?
- What are the biggest challenges someone in this position would face?
- What are the most important qualities for someone to excel in this role?
- How do you measure success in this position?

### About the Organization:

- What are the company’s objectives this year?
- How would you describe the company or team culture?
- What do most people enjoy about working here?
- What are some of the company’s biggest challenges right now?

### About Career Development:

- What opportunities are there for career growth and advancement within the company?
- How does the company support ongoing training and development?
- What would a typical path to leadership look like?
- How do you see the company evolving over the next five years?
- What are some of the next steps in the hiring process?
